

Cheap and Easy Silver Cleaner

I have used this method safely on serving pieces and fine jewelry. It works very well. A lot easier and less messy than any of the paste-style cleaners I have used. I can't compare it to Tarnex because I was always afraid of that stuff.

You will need:

- Heat resistant glass dish deep enough that the items to be cleaned will be completely immersed in water.
- Aluminum foil
- Baking Soda
- Boiling Water
- Some silver that needs cleaning

Directions:

Start the water to boil.

Line the glass dish with the aluminum foil...SHINY SIDE UP..this is important!

Place the silver that needs cleaning in the dish.

Sprinkle with at least two tablespoons of baking soda.

Pour the boiling water over the items. Pour slowly. The water will bubble up.

Allow to sit for about thirty seconds. You will smell the sulfur. Remove the items carefully from the water. Rinse and DRY.

Notice the tarnish clinging to the aluminum foil.
